


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## **Synopsis**

The last heir of the Karmash tribe recollects his now-forgotten ancestral traditions. He wanders through fragmented memories of his past, his lineage, and the city, which is slowly fading into the ruins of his consciousness. A portrait of a man on the verge of familial madness.




#### **Director's Statement**

Karmash is my attempt to blend historical fiction with a touch of magic realism, while creating a film that explores the themes of cultural identity, memory and traditions.

Through the protagonist's memoire-like narrative which serves partly as a subliminal political allegory, I intended to capture the subject of repressed identity and persecution of minorities. For me, the protagonist's 'bizarre' behavior and his ancestral tradition mimics the 'perceived' representation of the minority, often imposed by the oppressor.

Horror as a genre favored me with its unique ability to capture the existential melancholy and haunted 'otherness' of my protagonist.



## Director's Biography

Aleem Bukhari (born 1996) is a Pakistani visual artist, writer, and filmmaker. He began his career in 2016 with independent and experimental music videos before venturing into narrative filmmaking.

His notable works include Sapola (2018), Aik Do Teen (2019), and Anaari Science (2024), all of which received major accolades at the FILUMS International Film Festival. In late 2024, he wrote and directed the experimental horror short film Karmash.

Bukhari's work often—though not exclusively, incorporates genre-bending science fiction and occult horror themes, characterized by an eccentric visual style. His narratives frequently focus on working-class characters.

Beyond filmmaking, Bukhari is also known for his avant-garde digital illustrations and photography.


#### Irfan Noor K


